From I-90/Spokane, WA

Please inform drivers that if they use GPS/Map Quest/Google Maps they will be directed North on Hwy 25 and will head toward Canada with few areas to turn around in!

Exit I-90 at Hwy 395/Colville/Newport Exit

Travel North out of Spokane on Hwy 395 toward Colville (about 65 miles)

After Colville, continue North on Hwy 395 to Kettle Falls (about 12 miles)

Upon leaving Kettle Falls you will go under a railroad bridge

Take first Left after Chevron Station, which is Hwy 25 SOUTH

Road signs will say Hunters and Davenport

## DO NOT TURN RIGHT as instructed by GPS!

Immediately go under another railroad bridge

Travel just under 12 miles South on Hwy 25

We are just past mile marker 70, go up a slight grade you will see our trees on the right side (the river side) of the road

Our sign is on the right and the driveway is immediately before the sign Pull right into the yard and follow the pavement to the right in front of the shop Someone will meet you to direct you where to back in for loading.

## From Hwy 2

Follow road signs to Kettle Falls/Hwy 25

We are three miles north of Rice

Just past mile marker 69

As you round a corner, you will see our nursery on the left (river side of road)

You will see our sign and driveway on the left

Pull into yard and follow pavement to the right in front of the shop

Someone will meet you to direct you where to back in for loading.

<sup>\*</sup>If you arrive the night before your appointment, you may park in our yard overnight. We have no amenities, only a Honey Bucket and waterspout.

<sup>\*</sup>Many times drivers park along the road in the turnouts along the river, beautiful.

<sup>\*\*</sup>Kettle Falls has two places to park overnight:

<sup>\*</sup>TJ's Tavern, just as you enter town on the right, will allow you to park behind their place, with their permission. They are a local gathering place for dinner (very good food) and not a noisy bar atmosphere.

<sup>\*</sup>Chevron Station, at the end of town, has a spot to park overnight and has a laundry, shower, Subway, mini mart and fuel.
